

Proof - New Years Updates at HousingPlus

This month, we completed a six-month project to make our community room ADAaccessible. Thanks to a generous grant as part of Lowe's Hometowns Project, all of our tenants and community members, regardless of ability, will be able to enjoy our gathering space for group meetings, tenant events, and so much more. As we continue to recover from the effects of the Covid pandemic, we are excited to be able to begin hosting our growing community in this newly renovated space.



Your continued support allows us to do more than provide housing; it enables HousingPlus to provide therapy, employment assessments, community engagement, and more.



HousingPlus staff have also been busy this month. Dr. Mignon Carpenter, our Senior Director of Permanent Supportive Housing, joined volunteers throughout the city for the annual NYC Homeless Outreach Population Estimate (HOPE) on January 24th. Over a single night, volunteers canvassed streets, subway stations, and other public spaces across the city to identify individuals living unsheltered.

Dr. Carpenter said of her experience: "As for the HOPE count, it was a wonderful experience that helped to ground me in the important work we do here at HousingPlus. I am exhausted, and every part of my body hurts, including my eyelashes and fingertips, but I would do it all over again if given the opportunity."
